Responsibilities

- Plan, provide and evaluate speech, language, dysphasia and cognitive-linguistic treatment services
- Evaluate, recommend and train residents on use of augmentative devices and adaptive equipment
- Assess outcomes of treatments regularly and participate in plan modifications
- Maintain records on residents' progress
- Collaborate with interdisciplinary health care team and other Inglis House staff to provide quality care

Qualifications

- Speech Therapist licensure in Pennsylvania. Certificate of Clinical Competence in speech language pathology (or clinical fellowship year eligible).
- Familiar with needs of people with physical disabilities
- Good communication skills
